

Parent Safety Checklist for School Transportation

Driver Verification

- Verify the driver's government-issued ID and driving license.
- Ensure the driver has experience in school transportation.

- Check for functional seat belts or safety bars.

Emergency Readiness

- Ensure the transport provider has an SOS mechanism.
- Confirm availability of backup drivers in emergencies.
- Check if parents are notified instantly during incidents.
- Ensure insurance coverage for children.

School Coordination

- Ensure the school is aware of the transport arrangement.
- Confirm authorized drop points inside or near school premises.
- Verify handover procedures between driver and school staff.

Parent Awareness

- Educate children on basic road and travel safety.
- Teach children how to raise alerts if uncomfortable.
- Regularly review safety updates from the transport provider.
